**"Should Marijuana Be Legalized?"  
Issue to be Debated in Simulated Trial at Thomas Jefferson School of Law

SAN DIEGO -- The national debate on the legalization of marijuana continues this Friday evening, August 23, at the Thomas Jefferson School of Law (TJSL) as the law school and the San Diego Debate Society present a simulated trial proceeding, complete with direct and cross-examination of expert witnesses. The event is titled "Should Marijuana Be Legalized? Issues on Trial."
